**The Fall 40 Days for Life campaign** runs from September 27- November 5, 2023. The campaign involves prayer and fasting, peaceful vigil, and community outreach. The peaceful vigil (praying outside the abortion clinic) is the most visible component of the campaign.

**Where is the peaceful vigil?** We need to be at least 50 m from the abortion clinic (Woman's Health Options - 12409 - 109 A Ave., Edmonton).

**When is the vigil?** The vigil is from 7 am - 7 pm daily throughout the 40 days.

**Where do we get signs?** Signs can be picked up at St. Andrew's Church (12810 - 111 Ave.) - inside double wooden doors (that are facing 111 Ave.) - they are under the table in a Rubbermaid tote. Church hours are 7 am – 9 pm daily.

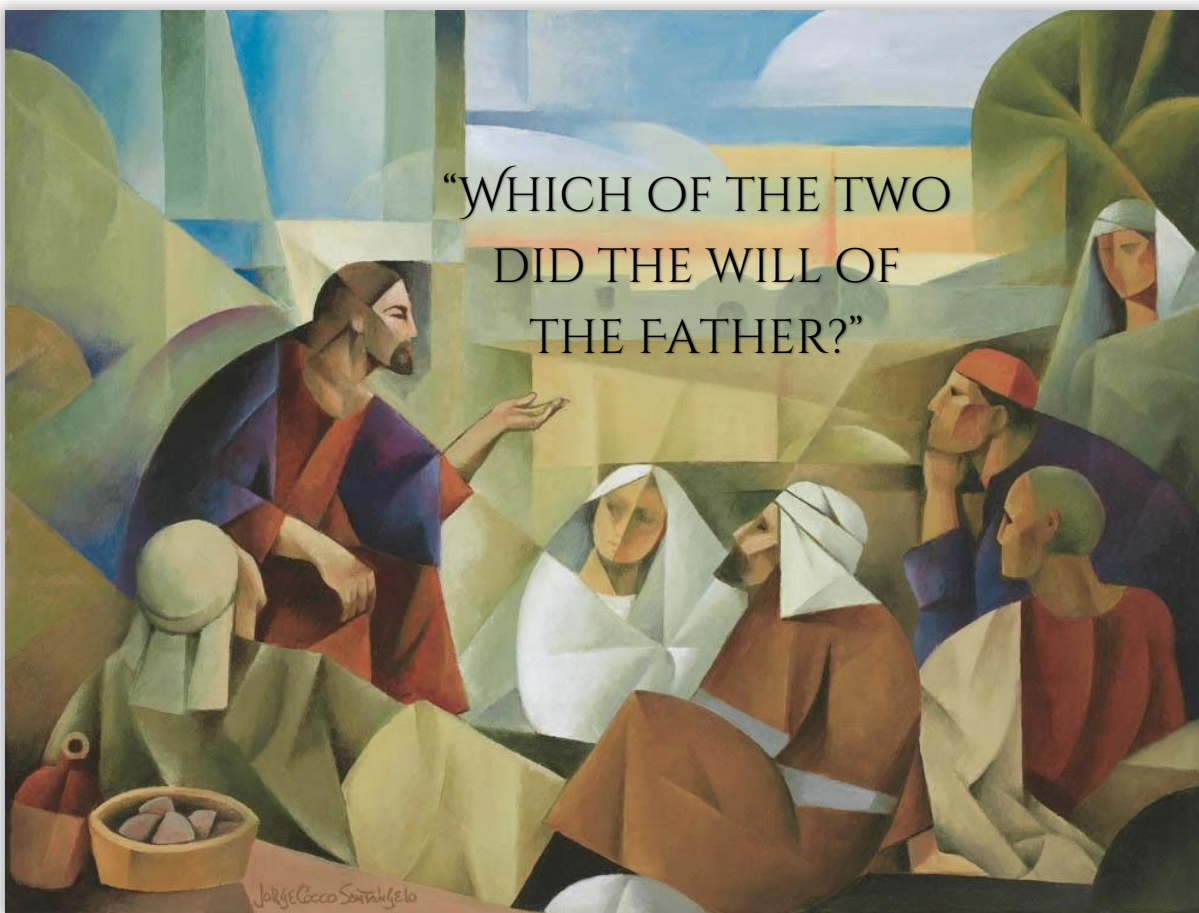
