Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, alleluia, alleluia **Psalm 138.18, 5-6**








E A S T E R S E A S O N

The liturgical season of Easter encompasses seven weeks, commencing on Easter Sunday and culminating with Pentecost. Revered by St. Athanasius as "the great Sunday," this period is observed as a singular, extended Feast Day. Our celebration during this time is marked by joyful singing of Alleluia, and the Marian antiphon Regina Caeli (Queen of Heaven) is recited instead of the Angelus.

Queen of Heaven (Regina Caeli)

- V. Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia.
- R. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia.
- **V**. Has risen, as he said, alleluia.
- R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.
- **V**. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.
- R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray. O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
