The Table of Fellowship

Sitting together for a meal can generate a special feeling of togetherness. Each of us will have our own memories of table companionship or fellowship. Many of these will be happy experiences of celebration and laughter, of love received and shared. Some memories of table fellowship may be sad times when we were more aware of one who was absent than of those who were present.

Jesus often shared meals with his disciples, using those moments to share his vision of God's kingdom. Around the table, the disciples truly absorbed his mind, heart, and spirit. Of all these gatherings, the most unforgettable was their final meal together: the Last Supper. This last meal captured the imagination of generations of disciples right up to ourselves. Jesus did more than share his vision with the disciples; He gave them himself in a way he had never done before, and in a way that anticipated the death he would die for them and for all, on the following day. In the form of the bread and wine of the meal, he gave and declared Himself to be their food and drink. At the same time, when He called on them to take and eat, to take and drink, he asked them to be with Him and give themselves to him as he was giving himself to them.

It was because of the last meal that we are here in this church today. Jesus intended his last supper to be a beginning rather than an end. It was the first Eucharist. Since then, the Church has gathered regularly in his name to do and say what he did and said at the Last Supper. We take bread and wine, bless them, break the bread, and share both for his disciples to eat and drink.

When we come to Mass and receive the Eucharist, we make a number of important statements. We acknowledge Jesus as our bread of life, the only one who can satisfy our deepest hungers. We also declare that, in response to his faithfulness to us, we will be faithful to him all our lives —one that ultimately means taking up the cross.

Celebrating the Eucharist is never something to be taken lightly. We must remember that every time we gather for the Eucharist, we are transported back to the Upper Room. There, alongside the first disciples, the Last Supper and all its sacred meaning are made alive and present to us once more. ■

Pope Leo XIV's First Encyclical Letter: Magnifica Humanitas

Pope Leo XIV's Encyclical Letter, [Magnifica Humanitas](#), was released today. It focuses on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence. The letter is dated 15 May, to commemorate the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's Encyclical Letter, [Rerum Novarum](#).

The Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development offers the following synopsis of the Encyclical Letter: “*Magnifica Humanitas* offers insights into the protection of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence, recognizing a profound epochal shift. It places the dignity of the human person at the centre as the criteria for guiding technical progress. The Church's social teaching accompanies these transformations, pointing to the common good, solidarity and subsidiarity as the fundamental benchmarks for understanding and interpreting the transformation currently underway. It proposes, as an alternative to the culture of power and war, a civilization of love founded on justice, dialogue and shared responsibility.”

To accompany the Encyclical Letter, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has prepared a collection of resources on the topic of artificial intelligence.
